Our Philosophy

Our toddler program and our preschool program are carefully created to help each child reach their developmental milestones with nutturing, hands-on, and stimulating materials.

It's very important to us that our students learn in vibrant environments prepared by caring teachers, giving learners everything that they need to develop habitual behavior, abilities, and perspectives that help them grow into happy adults with fulfilling lives.

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Building A Strong Foundation:

Children that build deep connections become self-assured and confident students that can tackle whatever comes their way with ease.

Cultivating Essential Skills:

Vital social skills, fine and gross motor skills, and emotional regulation.

Encouraging Wholeness and Growth:

Not only do Montessori children gain the confidence and skillsets they need to excel academically, but they are also highly motivated, flexible, and growth-orientated human beings.

Our mission is to help children create building blocks of success that last for the rest of our lives. The Montessori method and materials help children lay that foundation. The Orange Seeds Montessori stamp is a child who loves to learn, is curious about the world, and is on track to reach their full potential no matter what challenges they may face along the way.



Toddler Program:

Aimed at children aged 12 months to 2.5 years old.

Our toddler program is developmentally aligned to encourage the flourishing of language, concentration, problem-solving, and physical coordination. We achieve this by promoting an ever-increasing amount of independence (according to their individual abilities) in the following activities:

- Cleaning themselves, getting dressed, using the bathroom, and eating (this teaches self-care)
- Cleaning messes, getting food ready to eat, and food service (this teaches care for one's environment)
- Walking, climbing, running, jumping, balancing (this teaches gross motor skills)
- Reaching, grasping, picking up objects using tools and utensils, and making artwork (this teaches fine motor skills)
- Naming objects, describing actions and intentions, discussing pictures, practicing conversation, and making music (this
 encourages language development)
- Developing manners through interactions with peers and teachers and participating in small adult-led group games (this
 teaches social skills)

The Casa Program:

Aimed at children aged 2.5 to 6 years.

Our preschool program is designed to allow children to take control of their education through ownership and accountability. Our teachers function as guides and mentors, introducing new activities and lessons that are appropriate for each individual child.

We focus on five areas of study for preschoolers: Practical Life, Sensorial, Math, Languages, and Cultural Studies.

- Practical Life Skills: Dressing, preparing snacks, caring for plants, and social skills.
- Sensorial: Learning to perceive the world through all five senses by describing their experiences.
- Math: Identifying and matching numerals. Basic mathematical concepts and patterns in the numbering system.
- Language (English and French): Grow vocabulary while learning letter-sounds and combining them to make words with confidence.
- Cultural Studies: Introduction to history, geography, science, music, and art through integrated lessons.




